

RESOLUTION NO. 14-01

A RESOLUTION OF SELLERSVILLE BOROUGH, BUCKS COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, ESTABLISHING A FEE SCHEDULE FOR ALL BUILDING, SUBDIVISION, LAND DEVELOPMENT, ZONING AND HEARING BOARD FEES, AND OTHER MISCELLANEOUS APPLICATION AND PERMITTING FEES.

I SUBDIVISION AND LAND DEVELOPMENT

A. Formal Sketch Plan Review

1. Fee:
 - (a) Lot Line Change – Minor Subdivision: \$300.00
 - (b) Major Subdivision / Non-Residential: \$600.00
2. Professional Services Escrow Account: \$2,500.00

NOTE: A contract for professional services establishing the professional services escrow account shall be executed whenever a professional services escrow account is required. The professional services escrow account shall be required to be deposited with the Borough at the time of initial application. Where the professional services escrow account gets below fifty percent (50% of the original escrow monies deposited, the applicant is required to replenish the account back to the original escrow amount.

*1 Any filing fees incurred by applicants by first proceeding through the optional sketch plan phase shall be credited towards any filing fees incurred upon preliminary plan submission. Any amounts remaining in the professional services escrow account upon completion of the optional sketch plan phase shall be rolled over into the professional escrow account required to be established upon preliminary plan submission.

*2 Any amounts remaining in the professional services escrow account upon completion of the preliminary plan phase shall be rolled over into the professional escrow account required to be established upon final plan submission.

III BUILDING PERMIT FEES – NEW CONSTRUCTION - RESIDENTIAL
 All building and construction permits will be charged an additional \$4.00 PA Labor and Industry Permit Fee.

- A. Residential: Single Family Detached
1. First 2,500 square feet of Gross Floor Area (GFA): \$1,355.00
 Gross Floor Area includes garages, corridors, stairs, closets, and 1/2 of any basement. Crawl spaces with a maximum height of three (3) feet are excluded from Gross Floor Area calculations.
 2. Add \$0.30 per square foot above 2,500 square feet total square foot area.
- B. Residential – Multi-Family
1. Each unit up to 2,500 square feet of GFA: \$1,355.00
 2. Add \$0.30 per square foot above 2,500 square feet total square foot area.
 3. For three (3) or more dwelling units – commercial rates apply.
- C. Modular/Manufactured: \$800.00

IV BUILDING PERMIT FEES – ALTERATIONS, ADDITIONS, AND/OR ACCESSORIES

- A. Residential
1. Addition: \$624.00
 Electrical, plumbing and mechanical permits are additional.
 2. Alteration: \$170.00
 Electrical, plumbing and mechanical permits are additional. Includes up to two (2) inspections.
 3. Decks: \$335.00
 4. Electrical Permit: \$170.00
 5. Mechanical Permit: Includes two (2) inspections: \$170.00
 6. Plan Reviews \$100.00/hour
 7. Plumbing Permit: Includes two (2) inspections: \$170.00
 8. Roofing Replacement: Includes one (1) inspection: \$86.00
- B. Detached / Accessory Buildings
1. Garages / Accessory structure: \$510.00
 Electrical, plumbing and mechanical permits are additional.
 2. Utility sheds under 200 square feet and one (1) story or less.
 No building permit required; however, a zoning permit is necessary.
- C. Swimming Pools
1. Above Ground Pool (24" depth or greater): \$200.00
 2. In-ground pool: \$850.00
 Electrical, plumbing and mechanical permits are additional.
 3. Hot Tub/Spa \$200.00
 4. Compliance Escrow \$500.00
- D. Commercial, Industrial, Shopping Center or other Non-Residential:
1. New construction and additions permit: \$2,300.00
 2. Alterations/Miscellaneous: \$935.00
 3. Engineering plan review: \$100.00/Hour
 4. General inspections: \$100.00/Hour
 5. Electrical/mechanical/plumbing inspections: \$100.00/Hour
 6. Agricultural:
 - (a) First 1,000 Square feet: \$150.00
 - (b) Each 1,000 Square feet: \$50.00



All fees set forth in prior Resolutions which are inconsistent to the fees set forth herein are hereby repealed.




