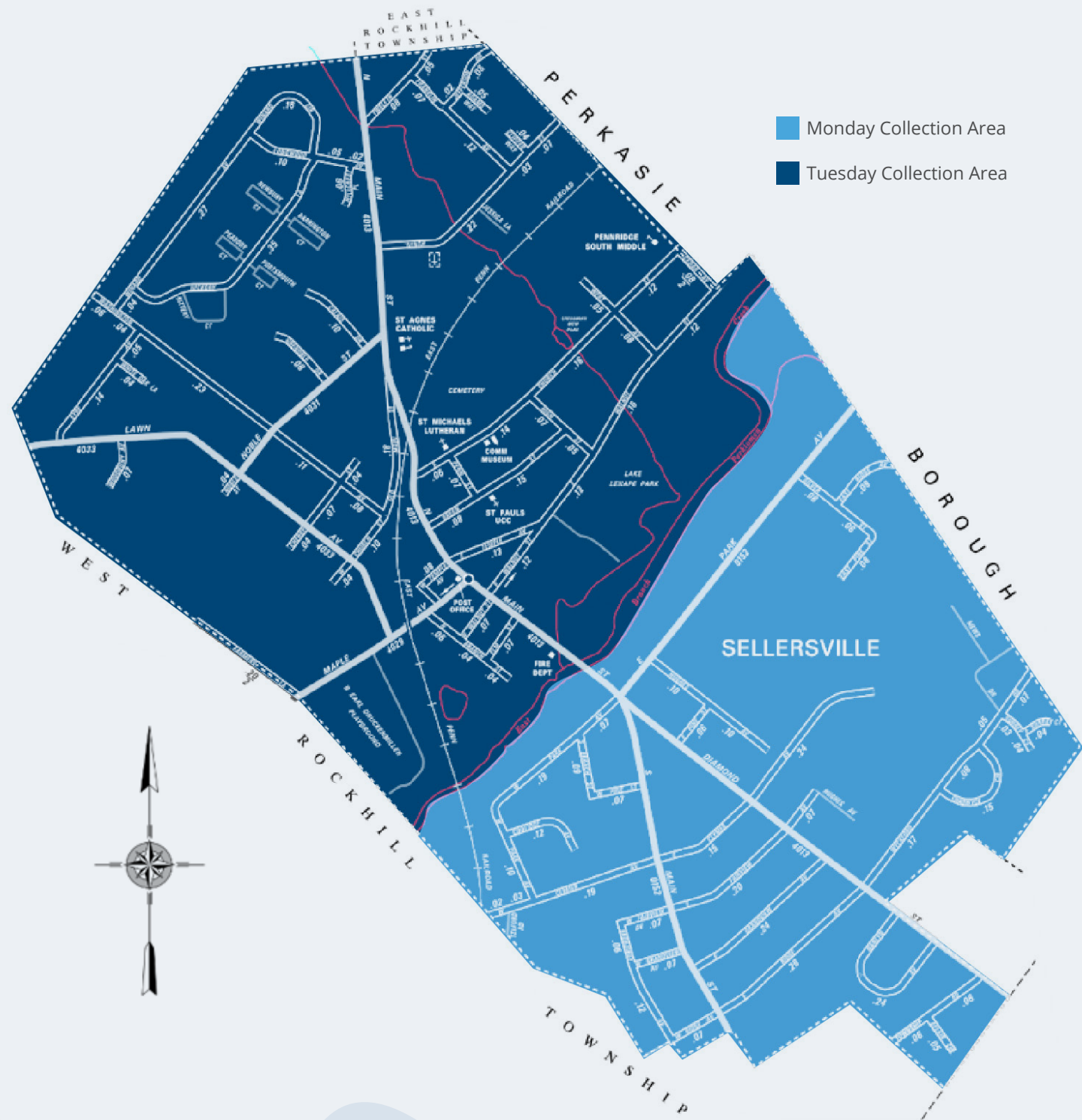


2026 Collection Map

Dear Borough of Sellersville resident,

Republic Services is pleased to be the trash services provider for Sellersville, and will now collect on new days during the week. We have provided the new collection schedule. Bulk will now be collected on the same day as your trash service. All items must be placed inside your cart with the lid closed. We provide the following services for Sellersville residents:

- ▶ Once-a-week solid waste.
- ▶ Once-a-week bulk serviced on your scheduled week. Trash will not be picked up as bulk items.

Recycling and trash carts will be delivered the week of **December 15, 2025**. Beginning **January 1, 2026**, you'll need to use Republic Services carts for recycling and trash collection.

Cart Placement Guidelines

- ▶ Carts must be placed 3 feet away from other carts or objects so our trucks can safely pick up the carts.
- ▶ If you live on a street with street parking, please place your cart on the sidewalk.
- ▶ Give at least 14 feet clearance above the cart from low branches.
- ▶ Make sure the cart handle faces the house.
- ▶ Do not block sidewalk access.
- ▶ Trash carts must be placed at the curb or in the alley by 7 a.m. on your collection day.
- ▶ Place used motor oil in clear 1-gallon jugs and in view of drivers.
- ▶ Do not dispose of electronics with regular trash.
- ▶ Loose materials, such as grass clippings and leaves, should be placed in bags and tied. Compostable bags are recommended.



Bulk Collection Service

- ▶ You are now allowed 1 bulk item per week on your regular trash service day.
- ▶ Please have items out by 7 a.m.
- ▶ There is a 50 lb. limit for all bulk items.
- ▶ Special pickups can be scheduled for a fee.
- ▶ Please refer to the map on the back.

Holiday Schedule

- Republic Services observes the following holidays, which will result in a one-day delay in service:
- ▶ **New Year's Day:** January 1
 - ▶ **Memorial Day:** Last Monday of May
 - ▶ **Independence Day:** July 4
 - ▶ **Labor Day:** First Monday of September
 - ▶ **Thanksgiving Day:** Fourth Thursday of November
 - ▶ **Christmas Day:** December 25

Recycling Dos and Don'ts

✓ **YES** Ensure all items are empty, clean and dry.



Paper

Office paper, newspaper, envelopes, junk mail, phone books, brochures, magazines, catalogs



Cardboard

File folders, poster board, shipping boxes (folded flat), frozen food boxes, cardboard boxes



Plastic

Water bottles, take-out containers, soda bottles, detergent containers



Metal

Aluminum beverage cans, food cans, steel food containers



Glass

Bottles (clear, green and brown), jars
