MINUTES

C. Kuhn moved that the minutes of the August 6, 2020 meeting be approved. Motion was seconded by J. Deetz and passed with all in favor.

FINANCIAL BUDGET

The Authority reviewed the September financial reports. It was noted that Sellersville Borough provided an additional \$19,000 in support to the Joint Recreation Authority. A. Buck moved to approve the September 2020 financial reports. Motion was seconded by C. Kuhn and passed with all in favor.

MANAGER'S REPORT

POOL REPAIRS AND MAINTENANCE

Chair Miller stated that he has arranged for concrete sawcutting and backhoe work from Tony Bogner who will work on the pool within the next few weeks. The areas to be saw cut and dug up need to be marked ahead of time. Sellersville Borough Public Works will pump out the deep end and Manager Rivet will mark the areas to be dug up and saw cut. Kevin Deetz has volunteered to assist with pipe work as well.

UPDATE ON WEST ROCKHILL TOWNSHIP DONATION

Chair Miller stated that the West Rockhill Town Board of Supervisors discussed providing additional financial support at their last meeting but tabled action until their next meeting. Authority members agreed that the Holiday House Recreational facility is a joint venture and both municipalities need to contribute equally to it.

SELLERSVILLE MEMBER VACANCY

Manager Rivet reported that around the time the COVID-19 pandemic shutdowns occurred, advertisements were placed to solicit interested parties to become a member, but no one stepped forward. He has contacted the Borough mayor who had someone who expressed interest a long while ago, but he had not seen her since the pandemic began.

WEST ROCKHILL ELEMENTARY SCHOOL PTO EVENT

The West Rockhill Elementary PTO has approached the Authority regarding using the Holiday House parking lot for a movie night as a fund raiser. The Authority agreed to allow the use by the PTO. Chair Miller suggested that the event may provide a good warm-up and may indicate the possibility of success for future Joint Recreation Authority fundraisers.
